

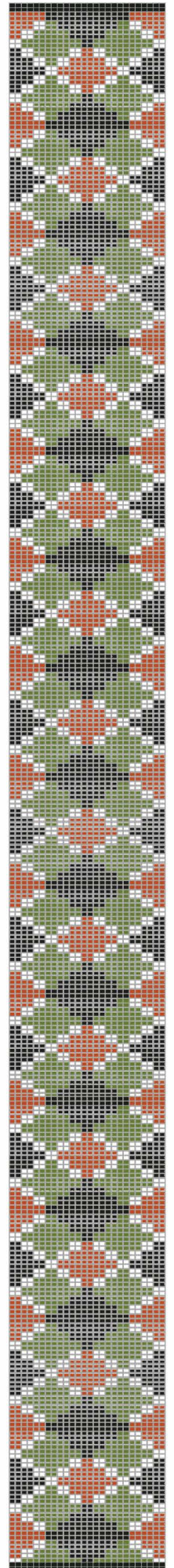
Caragh Thuring: "Camphor Amulet"

This is an Intarsia knit scarf.
Knitted in Aran weight yarn on 5mm needles.

You will need:

- 1 (100g) ball white
- 1 ball orange
- 1 ball green
- 1 ball black

- cast on 26sts in black.
- knit 2 rows stocking stitch.
- follow the pattern chart below (repeat every 24 rows) until the scarf measures 150cm or as desired.
- knit a final 2 rows stocking stitch in white.
- cast off and weave in ends.
