

## Annie Morris

This is a plain (stocking stitch) knitted scarf with duplicate stitch detail. Knitted on 5mm needles using Aran weight yarn.

You will need around 300g of yarn for the scarf and 50g for the detail. This is a good way to use up small odds and ends of yarn as you will only need a small amount of each colour.

- cast on 36 sts in your main yarn.
- knit 360 rows (until scarf measures 150cm).
- cast off.

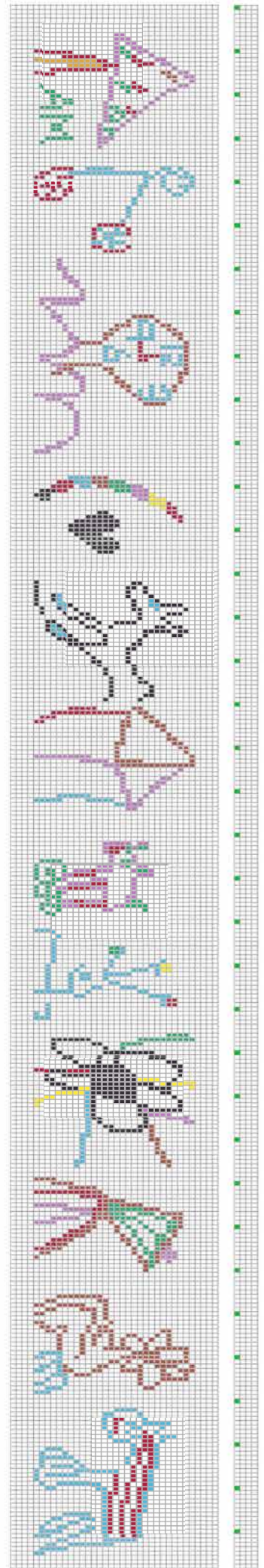
For the detail:  
Using duplicate stitch technique, follow the chart opposite to add the detail.

### Artist Biography

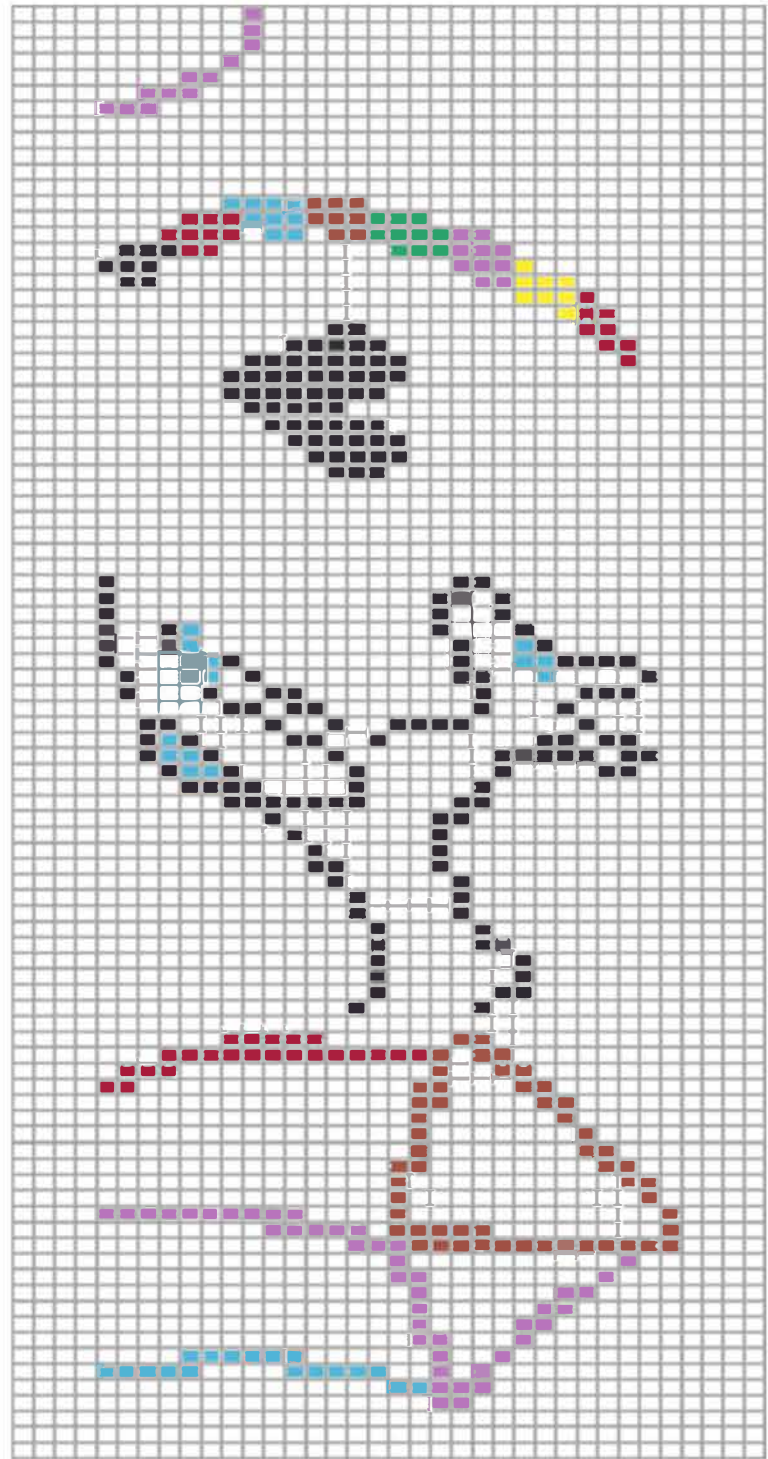
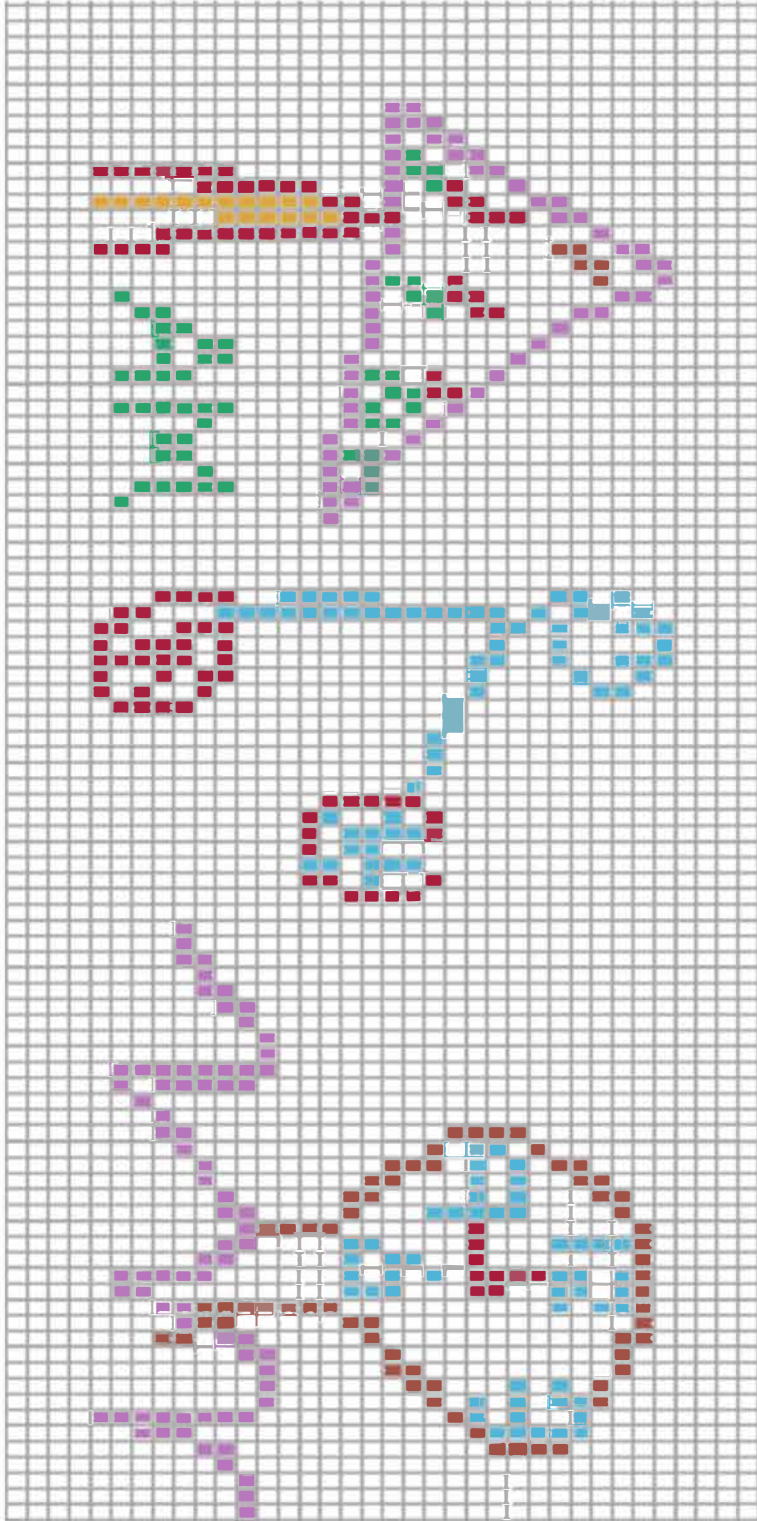
