



Bryony Phipps Wardle: NHS UNITED

This is an Intarsia knit scarf with duplicate stitch detail added. Knitted using Aran weight yarn on 5mm needles. You will need 100g each of blue and white yarn and small amounts of assorted rainbow colours for the tassels.


- cast on 36 sts in blue.
- knit 60 rows in stocking stitch.
- switch to the white yarn as the main and follow the intarsia pattern chart opposite.
- switch back to blue and knit another 60 rows.
- cast off and weave in the ends.
- For the duplicate stich detail use the white yarn on either end section, following the charts below.



- Finally added tassels to either end using the rainbow colured yarns.





Intarsia pattern chart

Bryony Phipps-Wardle is a designer, maker and researcher working in knit. Phipps-Wardle graduated the Royal College of Art in 2019; her developed methodology centres around the traceability of materials and responsible design and making. Traditional knit techniques are re-interpreted using a combination of hand and machine processes to create knitwear for a unisex market. Her practice has a strong material narrative and is interested in lesser told stories.

Here, the artist has designed a playful twist on classic football scarves, imagining our NHS as the ultimate team we can all support.
